

Trade Related Entrepreneurship Assistance and Development (TREAD)

The Trade Related Entrepreneurship Assistance and Development (TREAD) scheme is specifically for women entrepreneurs and is channelled through NGOs. Here's a checklist of documents typically required, but keep in mind there might be variations:

For NGOs Applying for TREAD Grants:

- **Completed Application Form:** Obtain the application form from the designated government agency or download it from their website (if available).
- **Registration Documents:**
 - Proof of NGO registration (Society/Trust/Company)
