

Raw Material Assistance Scheme (RMAS)

For all applicants:

- Completed Application Form: Obtain the application form from your nearest NSIC branch office or download it from the NSIC website https://www.nsic.co.in/schemes/raw-material-against-bg.aspx.
- Udyam Registration Certificate (URC): Self-attested photocopy as proof of MSME registration.
- GST Registration Certificate: Self-attested photocopy.
- Financial Statements:
 - Last year's audited financial statements.
 - Current year's provisional financial statements (if available).
- **Self-Attested Statement:** A statement outlining your personal assets & liabilities along with your residential address (proprietor/directors/partners/society office bearers).

Additional documents based on business structure:

- Private Limited Company:
 - o Copy of Memorandum of Association with a list of Directors.
 - Copy of Board Resolution authorizing the signatory to deal with NSIC.
- Partnership Firm:
 - Copy of Partnership Deed (notarized).
 - Copy of Power of Attorney.
- Society:
 - Copy of Governing Body Resolution authorizing the signatory to deal with NSIC.

Other:

- **Specimen Signatures:** Signatures of authorized signatory attested by the bank.
- **Bank Guarantee:** You may need a bank guarantee from an approved bank as security (depending on the credit option chosen).
